WHEN DOES THE CHAMPION CAMPAIGN START?

The campaign starts when you sign up.

WHAT IS THE JOB ROLE OF A CHAMPION?

Champions are asked to share the positive impacts of Scouting on our local youth and ask their Scouting network to philanthropically support those efforts. Each Champion will ask their Scouting friends and family to enroll in Keepers of the Flame, our sustained giving program.

WHAT ARE THE EXPECTATIONS OF THE CHAMPION?

The goal is for each Champion to enroll 5 individuals each week for 5 weeks. If each Champion enrolls 25 new Keepers of the Flame we will meet our overall goal!

WHAT ARE THE TIME REQUIREMENTS?

Each Champion will be giving a toolkit with suggestions on how to reach the Scouting network. This effort shouldn't take more than a couple hours each week.

WILL THE COUNCIL PROVIDE ME WITH A LIST OF PEOPLE TO CONTACT?

No. The Champion model utilizes peer-to-peer fundraising within your own Scouting network.

WHAT SUPPORT WILL THE COUNCIL PROVIDE ME?

The Council will give you a toolkit with collateral and tips on how to enroll new Keepers!

WHERE DOES THE MONEY RAISED GO?

Keepers of the Flame sustained giving supports budget relieving initiatives within operations of the Council. If you think of an iceberg image and everything about the water surface you see that keeps the Scouting movement alive like our camp properties, our programs, financial assistance for Scouts, etc. plus everything underneath to keep our operations running like utility bills, salaries, insurance, etc.
